**Required Baccalaureate & Graduation Dress Code for seniors:**

Academic Attire:

- Cap with tassel and academic gown
- NHS Stoles, academic honor cords, approved medals, ribbons, pins only

Ladies Dress Guidelines:

- Wear a dress or a skirt and a blouse
- Wear dress shoes, mindful of heel size because we will be walking stairs
- Jewelry conservative, one pair of earrings, no rope chains/necklaces
- No visible piercings or tattoos
- No purse, leave it with family members

Men's Dress Code:

- Wear a white dress shirt, neck tie and dress slacks
- Wear black or brown dress shoes and socks
- Gentlemen must be clean shaven
- No earrings or rope chains/necklaces
- No visible piercings or tattoos
